Cumbria Outdoors in collaboration with The Foundation for Common Land are supporting young people to complete The John Muir Discovery Award at hugely subsidised rates.

The John Muir Award is an environmental award scheme focused on wild places. It encourages people of all backgrounds to connect with, enjoy and care for wild places.

Programme is suitable for Primary, Secondary and SEND pupils with appropriate outdoors and conservation activities taking place during a residential experience at Hawse End Centre or Cottage. Offered during the Autumn Term 2024 and Spring Term 2025.

Sample Programme (4 Nights)



- **Day 1: AM Arrival** Centre induction. **PM** Explore the local area by foot, start to discover wild places, environment issues and solutions.
- **Day 2 & 3: Conservation** working alongside FCL and National Trust appropriate conservation project work.
- **Day 4 & 5:** Outdoor activities to allow the group to further explore wild places, enjoy the landscape, and learn new skills.

Outdoor activities will be dependent on age and ability of the group and prevailing weather conditions, but can be selected from the following:

Hill Walk, Canoeing on Derwentwater, Rock Climbing, Ghyll Scrambling, Bushcraft or Mine exploration. Depending on group ability can also offer: Archery, Orienteering, Raft Building or Problem Solving.

The 4 Aims of the Award:

- 1 Discover a wild place.
- 2 Explore it.
- 3 Do something to conserve it.
- 4 Share your experiences.

The JMA Discovery Award requires 25+hrs of activity, some sessions can take place at school pre or post the residential.

Theis subsidised residential starts at only £145 per pupil based on 3 nights, and just £194 per pupil for 4 nights. (Prices may vary slightly, based on group sizes).
